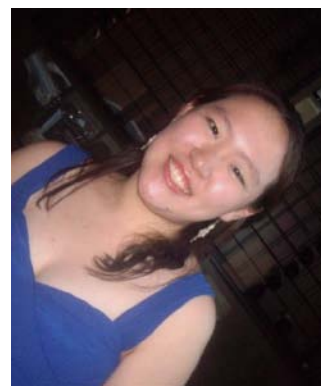

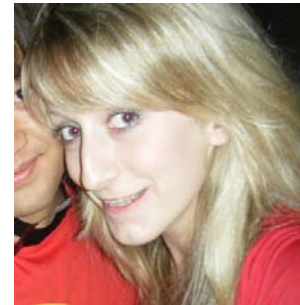
Hello Second Yearians :)
